Students need to bring their completed Genius Hour projects to school on Tuesday, May 14th.

6. Closing Down the Class Website

This summer, the class website will be discontinued and replaced by Canvas. For the remainder of the school year, I will be transferring features of the class website to Canvas.

As of next Monday (4/15) all future assignments will be posted on Canvas only. In Canvas, assignments will be posted in one of the five classes: Math, Language Arts, Social Studies, Science, and Technology.

All assignments posted **before 4/15** will still be available on the class website until the end of the school year. Any assignments posted on **4/15** or **later** will only be posted on Canvas.

Your fifth grader has already accessed several assignments via Canvas at school and should be familiar with the process. If they are having problems accessing assignments at home through Canvas, please let me know.
