

# PEORIA LAPTOPS FOR LEARNING

During school closures, we are working to offer student learning opportunities at home. Since some families may not have a device, laptops will be available to check out for those students who will require the use of one for learning at home. Families should plan to share devices among students at home if possible.

# LAPTOP CHECK-OUT PROCEDURES

# Drive Up → Check In → Log In → Go

A parent/guardian and the student(s) must all be present to check out a laptop.

1. Pickup stations available at three high schools.

Peoria, Liberty and Centennial.

2. Check the pick-up schedule for your student.

## 3. Drive up to the pickup station.

You MUST stay in the vehicle.

#### 4. Fill out a form to check in.

The form requires the student's name, contact information and student ID. Parents/guardians will be responsible for their student's use of the devices and returning them to the school undamaged when requested.

## 5. Student must log in on the laptop.

Before leaving the school campus, park in the parking lot. The student will need to use their login credentials to connect with the district network. Without this initial connection the laptop will not be operational.

To use the laptops, students will require connection to the Internet to access instructional resources. Access is accomplished via the family's home Internet service such as Cox, Century Link or other similar Internet service provider. Most smart phones may be used to set-up a "Hot-Spot" that can provide Wi-Fi access to the Internet. If a student's family does not have Internet access, several Internet service providers are offering very low-cost packages that are suitable for student use. Cox and T-Mobile are two such providers, but there are several others. The Peoria Unified School District cannot and is not endorsing any particular service provider.

Please note that the capability to print from the student laptops will not be provided by the district.
