AASA Writing Test – Tuesday 4/02

Our next round of state testing is the AASA Writing Test on Tuesday, 4/02.

Bring Snacks and Books

Students are also welcome to bring snacks to eat during testing – but please no gum, hard candies, or anything with nuts.

Future Testing Dates

These are the dates for the remaining state tests:

April 16 – AASA reading/math part 1

April 18 – AASA reading/math part 2

Please avoid pulling out your fifth grader on these days. If a student starts a testing session and then is pulled out of school, they are not permitted to resume their test when they return.
