	Criteria
<b>20%</b>	<b>Presentation Style</b>
/5	We can see and hear you clearly throughout the entire presentation. ( <b>Note</b> – if you can't be seen or heard in your presentation, <b>your project will be graded as incomplete.</b> )
/5	Information is presented orally with support from pictures, graphs, or models. Information <b>MUST NOT</b> be presented as blocks of text typed on the screen.
/5	All elements of the video presentation are related to answering your question – no random effects or anything distracting.
/5	Presentation is energetic and engaging.
<b>40%</b>	<b>Graphic Element</b>
/20	Presentation is supported by a student-designed and created graphic element such as a poster, Minecraft build, diorama, or model.
/20	Graphic element demonstrates effort and student's personal-best work.
<b>40%</b>	<b>Information Presented</b>
/15	Information is presented by paraphrasing (in the student's own words) and not copied and read from other sources.
/15	Information presented fully answers the student's project question in complete detail.
/10	All information presented is related to answering the question. No "random facts".
